# Peggy Blair: Experiences Publishing a Book

Come and hear Peggy Blair talk about the experience of writing mystery books and getting them published. On top of being an author, Peggy worked as a lawyer for over thirty years and was considered an expert in Indigenous law. She was also a Crown prosecutor and criminal defence lawyer and sat on the Canadian Rights Tribunal.

Peggy has traveled to Cuba, going to Old Havana for a Christmas. There she people-watched, went to the bars favored by Hemingway, and discovered how to make a great mojito. She has been named in the Canadian Who's Who.

Blair has written five mystery novels. The Beggar's Opera was published in 2012 by Penguin Canada as well internationally. It was shortlisted for the UK Debut Dagger Award and won the Giller Prize Reader's Choice Award. It was followed by The Poisoned Pawn, and then Hungry Ghosts, and Umbrella Man which were published by Simon and Schuster Canada and which she has recently put back in print. Her latest novel, Shadow Play, is set in Ottawa around an LRT scandal and can be ordered

### Brockville Railway Tunnel, Wednesday April 24th. 2024

**The Brockville Railway Tunnel** was Canada's first railway tunnel constructed between 1854 and 1860 as part of the Brockville and Ottawa (B&O) Railway. The B&O tied the St. Lawrence River to the Ottawa River to take part in the lucrative timber trade. The B&O was chartered in 1853. The restoration of the historic tunnel was completed during 2016 - 2017 for Canada's 150th. birthday.
